Each bidder shall take into consideration the number of days for completion of the project as specified in the Agreement. Payment for all work performed and materials furnished for construction by the Contractor shall be made in cash or check upon completion of the contract and acceptance of work by the City.

Construction covered hereby will be subject to all requirements of the Prevailing Wage Law of the State of Missouri and to the wage rates determined by the Industrial Commission of Missouri and set forth in the Contract Documents. Prior to award of this Contract, the Contractor and all sub-contractors may be required to furnish evidence of a written Affirmative Action Program to ensure that all employees are treated equally without regard to their race, color, religion, sex, handicap or national origin, pursuant to Executive Order #11246 and amendments thereto. It is the policy of the City of Independence, Missouri, to buy products manufactured, assembled, or produced in Missouri if the quality and price are comparable with other products and USA products if the price is not increased by more than 10 percent.
