## 24 HIGHWAY CORRIDOR UPDATE

Councilmember Curt Dougherty and Councilmember John Perkins hosted a public meeting at Mid-Continent Public Library on December 7, 2016 to discuss the 24 Highway Corridor. Approximately 45 people attended the meeting. A new code enforcement project is being undertaken by the City of Independence.

Beginning December 12, 2016 properties along 24 Highway from the Western City Limits east to Dickinson Road will be inspected for Business Licenses, tall grass/weeds, proper Signage, prohibited open storage, proper screening, building maintenance, trash and non-operable vehicles. The plan is for all initial inspections to be completed by January 31, 2017.

Councilmember Dougherty has been meeting with civic and other government officials to receive input on how to improve the 24 Highway Corridor. We will keep you posted.
