

Resurfacing on Route 24 Begins March 21



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INDEPENDENCE, MO: Resurfacing work for Route 24/Independence Avenue between Ewing Ave. and Route 291 begins Monday, March 21 through July 15. Work begins in the westbound lanes after morning rush hour, at approximately 9 a.m., restricting traffic through the area. All work is weather dependent.

Following the work on westbound lanes, crews will begin pavement repairs and resurfacing on eastbound Route 24. All westbound lanes will remain open from 6 a.m. to 9 a.m. and all eastbound lanes from 3 p.m. to 7 p.m. Motorists should expect delays and seek an alternate route if possible.

In addition to the resurfacing work, crews will need to conduct bridge repairs to the Route 24 Bridge over Delaware Street, beginning Monday, March 28, reducing the bridge to one lane in each direction through the end of April.

Work includes full-depth pavement repairs and a new driving surface to provide a smoother, safer drive for the more than 19,000 motorists using this road daily.

Motorists are reminded to slow down and pay attention as they drive past work zones. Not all work zones look alike. We remind motorists that work zones can be moving operations, such as striping, patching or mowing. They can also be short term, temporary lane closures to make quick repairs or remove debris from the roadway.
