Traffic Signal Control (Updates)



In accordance with authority granted to the Director of Public Works by Chapter 18, Article 2, Section 18.02.001, paragraph B., of the City Code, the following emergency traffic code changes shall be implemented. The changes shall be effective immediately and shall be implemented into permanent City Code with subsequent changes to the City Traffic Code Schedule.

Add: Lexington Street and River Boulevard
M-78 and Truman Road

(d) Right Turn on Red Not Allowed at Signalized Intersections

Remove: ~~Lexington Street (eastbound) at River Boulevard~~
