Notice is hereby given to the registered qualified voters of Jackson County, Missouri, that the City Council of the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri has called a Special Election to be held on Tuesday, November 6, 2007. Shall the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri, annex unincorporated territory adjacent to it, as described in Ordinance No. 6471, passed and adopted by the City Council of the City of Lee's Summit on August 27, 2007?

The Southeast Quarter of Section 10, Township 47, Range 31, in Jackson County, Missouri.

The South half (S ½) of Section Eleven (11), Township Forty-Seven (47), Range Thirty-One (31), except a tract described as beginning at a point on the South line of the Southwest Quarter (SW ¼) of Section Eleven (11), Nine Hundred feet (900') East of the Southwest corner of the Southwest Quarter (SW ¼) of said Section Eleven (11); thence North at right angles Six Hundred Sixty feet (660'); thence East at right angles Six Hundred Sixty feet (660'); thence South at right angles Six Hundred Sixty feet (660') to the South line of the Southwest Quarter of Section Eleven (11); thence West along said South line Six Hundred Sixty feet (660'), more or less, to the point of beginning, all being in Township Forty-Seven (47) North, Range Thirty-One (31) West, Jackson County, Missouri.

All that part of the Southwest ¼ of Section 12, Township 47, Range 31, in Jackson County, Missouri, lying South of U.S. Highway #50.

The Northwest ¼ of Section 13, Township 47, Range 31, in Jackson County, Missouri.

A tract of land in the Northeast ¼ of Section 14, Township 47 North, Range 31 West, in Jackson County, Missouri, described as follows: Beginning at the Northeast corner of said Section 14; thence due South along the East line of said Section 14, a distance of 885.00 feet; thence due West, a distance of 200.00 feet to a point of curvature; thence Southwesterly, along a curve to the left, radius of said curve being

2350.00 feet, a distance of 1248.20 feet; thence North 30 degrees 25 minutes 57 seconds West, a distance of 1030.00 feet; thence due North, a distance of 300.00 feet, more or less, to the North line of said Section 14; thence Easterly, along the North line of said Section 14, a distance of 1915.00 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning.

A tract of land in the Northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 14, Township 47 North, Range 31 West, in Jackson County, Missouri, more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the Northeast corner of said Section 14; thence South along the East line of said Section 14, 985.00 feet to THE TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING; thence due South along the East line of said Section 14, 1190.00 feet; thence due West, 240.00 feet; thence North 45 degrees 07 minutes 59 seconds West, 980.90 feet; thence North 22 degrees 45 minutes 54 seconds West, 350.00 feet; thence Northeasterly along a curve to the right, said curve having a radius of 2250.00 feet, the tangent to which bears North 67 degrees 14 minutes 06 seconds East from the last described point, 893.98 feet along said curve to a point of tangency; thence due East, 200 feet to True Point of Beginning.

The Northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 14, Township 47, Range 31, in Jackson County, Missouri, EXCEPT the West 330 feet of the North 1320 feet thereof, AND EXCEPT that part conveyed to Reorganized School District No. 7 by Warranty Deed dated December 30, 1968, and filed in the office of the Recorder of Deeds for Jackson County, Missouri, at Independence under Document No. I-30535 in Book I-87 at Page 475, as corrected by Correction Warranty Deed dated March 26, 1985, being more particularly described as follows: A tract of land in the Northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 14, Township 47 North, Range 31 West, more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the Northeast corner of said Section 14; thence due South along the East line of said Section 14, a distance of 885.00 feet; thence due West, a distance of 200.00 feet to a point of curvature ; thence Southwesterly, along a curve to the left, radius of said curve being 2350.00 feet, a distance of 1248.20 feet; thence North 30 degrees 25 minutes 57 seconds West, a distance of 1030.00 feet; thence due North, a distance of 300.00 feet, more or less, to the North line of said Section 14; thence Easterly, along the North line of said Section 14, a distance of 1915.00 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning, and except that part in streets or roadways. AND EXCEPT that part conveyed to Reorganized School District No. 7 by Warranty Deed dated December 30, 1968, and filed in the office of the Recorder of Deeds for Jackson County, Missouri, at Independence under Document No. I-30534 in Book I-87 at Page 472, being more particularly described as follows: A tract of land in the Northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 14, Township 47 North, Range 31 West more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the Northeast corner of said Section 14; thence due South along the East line of said Section 14, a distance of 985.00 feet to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING; thence due South along the East line of said Section 14, a distance of 1190.00 feet; thence due West, a distance of 240.00 feet;

thence North 45 degrees 07 minutes 59 seconds West, a distance of 980.90 feet; thence North 22 degrees 45 minutes 54 seconds West, a distance of 350.00 feet; thence Northeasterly along a curve to the right, said curve having a radius of 2250.00 feet, the tangent to which bears North 67 degrees 14 minutes 06 seconds East from the last described point, a distance of 893.98 feet along said curve to a point of tangency; thence due East, a distance of 200.00 feet to the True Point of Beginning.

That part of the Southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 14, Township 47, Range 31, in Jackson County, Missouri, lying North or Northerly of the following described line: Beginning at a point in the West line of said Southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 14, a distance of 1320.77 feet Northerly from the Southwest corner of said Section 14, measured along the Westerly line of said Southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 14; thence due East 2642.45 feet to a point on the East line of said Section 14.

The West 10 Acres of the Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 2, Township 47, Range 31, in Jackson County, Missouri, AND the East $\frac{1}{2}$ of the West $\frac{1}{2}$ of the Northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of the Southwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 2, Township 47, Range 31, in Jackson County, Missouri.

The West $\frac{1}{2}$ of the East $\frac{1}{2}$ of the Northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of the Southwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 2, Township 47, Range 31, in Jackson County, Missouri.

NOTICE OF ACCESSIBILITY

FURTHER NOTICE IS GIVEN that, where a regular polling place has limited accessibility, a disabled or elderly voter may be provided an alternative means of casting his or her ballot. Such means may include reassignment to an accessible polling place, curbside voting, assisted voting or voting by absentee ballot. A voter may apply for an absentee ballot in person or by mail, or may have a relative or guardian apply in person on his or her behalf. If an absentee voter is disabled or incapacitated, the notary requirement is waived. In addition, voters requiring assistance may be assisted by a person of the voter's choice.
