

Required Document Checklist for Residential Pools:

The following documents are required for review. Incomplete documents will not be accepted.

Completed Residential Building Permit Application. <u>Indep.us/residential building permit application</u>
Completed Pool Requirements & Checklist Sheet (see page 2)
Completed Plot Plan. (see page 4)
Permit Fee.

Pool Permit Fee: Pool permit fee is based on total gallons of water the pool will hold.

\$125 Less than 15,000 gallons \$175 15,000 gallons or more

Engineering Review Fee:

\$30

Electrical and plumbing fees are calculated individually on the value of work:

Value	Fee		Fee per thousand in value
\$1 - \$500	\$40		
\$501 - \$1,000	\$50		
\$1,001 - \$5,000 \$65			
\$5,001 and over	\$80 Base Fee	+	\$12 per thousand for remaining over \$5,000

Review time frames & reviewing departments

Pool permits will be reviewed within 5 business days from the day after submittal, and is reviewed by the following departments:

- **Building Review** 816-325-7401 Reviews to verify the pool will be install to the current adopted residential building code.
- **Zoning Review** 816-325-7421/7823 Reviews to verify proper setback requirements and design standards are met per the Unified Development Ordinance.
- **Engineering Review** 816-325-7591/7044 Reviews to verify the pool will not be built inside any easements, and will be drained to a proper sanitary sewer drain.

Licensing Requirements

Proper licensing will be required before the permit will be issued. Contractors must have the following licenses:


 Business License. A general business license is required, and may be applied for online at indep.us/general business license online application.
